## APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Unfasten straps and slide affected thumb into brace. Wrap and secure thumb strap (A) ensuring a snug fit (Figure 1).
- 2. Pull and wrap forearm strap (B). Secure when desired fit and level of compression is reached (Figure 2).
- 3. Pull and wrap wrist strap (C). Secure when desired fit and level of compression is reached (Figure 2).
- 4. Adjust straps as needed when swelling of the hand, wrist or thumb changes (Figure 3).

**NOTE:** Once fitted, excessive strap length may be trimmed with scissors.

## HEAT MOLDING INSTRUCTIONS

Heat molding should only be performed by medical professionals. Apply heat evenly to the area of interest using a heat gun. Heat only until soft enough to form. Brace should not be too hot to handle comfortably. Apply brace and press to mold into desired shape. Reheat and continue forming as necessary. Brace may also be trimmed with scissors.
